Do not line gravesites with stones or landscaping mulch of any kind as this can be dangerous to people and damaging to markers when mowing occurs. To prevent mosquito breeding, replace water in vases at least weekly. "Do Not Remove Flowers" signs may be requested at the cemetery office if it is near the anniversary of a date of birth or date of death.
