2020 HOLIDAY FLOWER REMOVAL SCHEDULE

We are pleased to relax our flower decorating requirements for the special holidays listed below. During these periods only light clean-ups will occur where the only items removed will be cut flowers that have wilted.

Please respect the rights of individual owners and the overall beauty of the park by keeping your decorations under 30 inches tall and limiting decorations to two items per gravesite. Decorating District trees or other property and erecting fences is not permitted. Please refrain from lining gravesites with stones of any type as these can be dangerous to people and damaging to markers and equipment when mowing occurs. To prevent mosquito breeding sources, please replace water in vases at least once a week.
